









What is Band Karate?

- Students will be able to earn Band Karate belts in class and outside of class by passing
 off the listed numbers for the various belts.
- This is a way for the teacher to hear individual students and for students to receive individualized feedback to help students improve on their instrument.
- Students are not being graded on how far they advance in the band karate belts, they are graded based on effort and progress!

<u>Is Band Karate required?</u>

- Yes, it is required that every student participate in passing off the band karate belt numbers when we pass off <u>during class</u>.
- Students must work in the order of the band karate belts. (Ex. White, Yellow, then Orange, then Green...)
- If the student does not pass the first time, no problem! Students can either submit another recording outside of class, or try it again when we do pass offs during class.
- Students are welcome to work ahead and submit recordings through Google Voice (see instructions below) to advance through the belts faster.



How do I submit a recording?

It's easy! All you need is a working phone!



- Dial- (913) 274-9245
- Say your first and last name, your school and which number you will be playing.
 - o The first time you call, it will ask you to state your name.
 - o After a few rings you will hear a message from Ms. Angelo with instructions.
 - o Do not start playing until AFTER you hear the message and the BEEP!
 - If you make a mistake, no problem! Just hang up and try again. If you are still not happy with your recording after two tries, practice a little more and try again the next day @
- When you are finished playing, hang up and I will receive a recording of you playing!
