

Materials Checklist for Each Instrument

Many of these items are normally packaged with instruments at the music store, but check to be sure.

Flute

- Tuning rod – used with Cleaning swab
- Silk cleaning swab (used inside the flute)



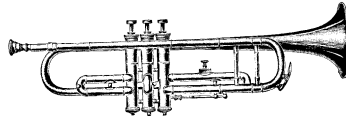
Clarinet

- (4) 2½ strength reeds – boxes of 10 are recommended (and priced cheaper)
 - Rico or Rico Royal are good brands of affordable reeds for beginners
 - Sometimes plastic reeds are a great option for beginners!
- Cloth pull-through cleaning swab
- Cork grease
- (Optional) Reed guard - stores reeds and keeps them flat and protected



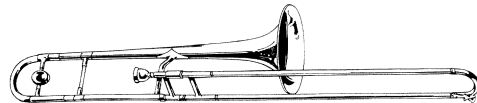
Trumpet

- Valve oil
- Tuning slide grease



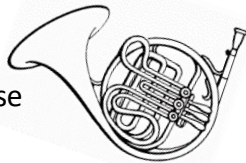
Trombone

- Slide Oil
- Tuning slide grease



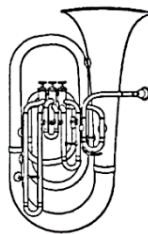
Horn

- Rotary Valve Oil
- Tuning slide grease



Baritone and Tuba

- Valve Oil
- Tuning slide grease



Percussion

- Percussionists should have a percussion kit with both bells/bell stand and a snare/snare stand. These kits should come with bell mallets, snare sticks, a practice pad and a drum key.
